





## DIRECTIONS

FROM NEWARK, take Garden State Parkway to exit 130 leading into U.S. Route 1 past New Brunswick circle to Princeton circle. Three-quarters around circle to Washington Road, then onto Hightstown Road. Right turn on Clarksville Road. Make first left turn to Penn-Lyle Road continuing to model homes.

FROM NEW YORK, take Lincoln or Holland Tunnel or George Washington Bridge to New Jersey Turnpike to Hightstown Exit 8. Proceed on U.S. Route 539 to Clarksville Road. Turn left on Clarksville Road and proceed as indicated above.

FROM PHILADELPHIA, take New Jersey Turnpike to Hightstown Exit 8 to U.S. Route 539 to Clarksville Road. Turn left on Clarksville Road and proceed as indicated above.
